Indication

ZYFLO CR is a medicine that is used to prevent asthma attacks and for long-term management of asthma in adults and children 12 years of age and older. ZYFLO CR blocks the production of leukotrienes. Leukotrienes are substances that may contribute to your asthma.

ZYFLO CR is not a rescue medicine (it is not a bronchodilator) and should not be used if you need relief right away for an asthma attack.

UNCONTROLLED ASTHMA SYMPTOMS CAN SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT EVERYDAY LIFE

Uncontrolled asthma symptoms may interfere with day-to-day life

DAILY ACTIVITIES, LIKE:

- Walking
- Going up stairs
- Sleeping
- Playing with children or pets
- Visiting friends or relatives

If your asthma is interfering with your daily activities, your symptoms may be uncontrolled

Your symptoms may be uncontrolled if:

- Your asthma symptoms keep you from getting as much done at work or school
- You have shortness of breath multiple times a week
- Your asthma symptoms (wheezing, coughing, shortness of breath, chest tightness, or pain) wake you up at night or earlier than usual in the morning
- You use your rescue inhaler or nebulizer medication multiple times a week

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HOW ZYFLO CR® (zileuton) WORKS

- ZYFLO CR works differently from other asthma medicines to help keep your symptoms under control every day
- ZYFLO CR blocks the production of something called leukotrienes (loo-ko-TRY-enz) that can be one of the causes of asthma symptoms
- Leukotrienes can cause inflammation and narrowing of the airways that lead to asthma symptoms
- By blocking the production of leukotrienes, ZYFLO CR works to prevent symptoms and help control your asthma

TAKING ZYFLO CR® (zileuton)

Take ZYFLO CR twice a day

- Take 2 tablets orally twice a day within 1 hour after morning and evening meals
- Tablets must be swallowed whole and should not be cut, crushed, or chewed



Liver monitoring with ZYFLO CR

- Liver enzymes may increase while taking ZYFLO CR and will have to be monitored periodically during treatment
- In a 6-month study, an increase in liver enzymes was seen in 1.8% of people taking ZYFLO CR compared to 0.7% in people who didn't take ZYFLO CR. Most cases resolved within 21 days after treatment was stopped
- Your doctor will do a blood test to check your liver enzymes before you start taking ZYFLO CR and then periodically during treatment to make sure levels stay normal

LIVER ENZYME MONITORING SCHEDULE

First 3 months	Once monthly
4–12 months	Every 2–3 months
After 12 months	Periodically while treatment continues

ZYFLO CONNECT PROGRAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

HOW IT WORKS

- If you are uninsured or have commercial insurance, Chiesi USA may help pay the out-of-pocket expenses (co-pay, co-insurance) of your prescription. For patients taking ZYFLO CR® (zileuton) extended-release tablets or ZYFLO® (zileuton) tablets, up to \$2,500 per month will be provided, if you meet the eligibility requirements below. If the total costs of your out-of-pocket expenses are over \$2,500 per month, you will be responsible for the outstanding balance.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR \$0 COPAY

- You are either:
 - Uninsured, or
 - You are insured by commercial or private insurance and your insurance does not cover the full cost of ZYFLO CR or ZYFLO
- Your prescriptions are not covered in full or in part by any Government-funded plan (Medicaid, Medicare Part D, etc.); patients who move from commercial to a Government-funded plan will no longer be eligible
- You are at least 18 years of age
- Void where prohibited by law

TERMS OF USE

- By accepting this offer and participating in the ZYFLO connect program, you are representing and warranting to Chiesi that you currently meet the eligibility requirements described above and will comply with these Terms of Use.

- Out-of-pocket benefit equals an amount up to \$2,500 per month (maximum benefit of \$30,000 per year) for ZYFLO CR or ZYFLO. Patient is responsible for applicable taxes, if any.
EXAMPLE: If your co-pay or out-of-pocket costs are no more than \$2,500, you pay \$0. For a mail-order 3-month prescription, your total maximum savings will be \$7,500 (\$2,500 x 3).

Important Patient Safety Information

Do not take ZYFLO CR if you have active liver disease, repeated blood tests showing elevated liver enzymes (substances released by the liver) or have ever had an allergic reaction to ZYFLO CR or any of the ingredients in ZYFLO CR.

ZYFLO CR may not be right for you. Tell your health care provider if you have ever had liver problems, including hepatitis, jaundice (yellow eyes or skin), or dark urine.

Tell your health care provider how much and how often you drink alcohol.

Tell your health care provider if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant. It is not known if ZYFLO CR will harm your unborn baby. Do not take ZYFLO CR during pregnancy unless you and your health care provider decide that taking the medicine is more important than the possible risk to your unborn baby. It is not known if ZYFLO CR passes into your breast milk. You and your health care provider should decide if you will take ZYFLO CR or breastfeed. You should not do both.

Tell your health care provider if you have difficulty swallowing pills and about all the medicines you take, including prescription and non-prescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

ZYFLO CR can cause serious side effects including liver problems. Liver function enzymes and bilirubin can increase while taking ZYFLO CR and severe liver injury can occur. Have your blood tests done as ordered to check your liver enzymes.

In addition, tell your healthcare provider if you have any sleep problems or changes in behavior while taking ZYFLO CR.

Tell your health care provider right away if you get any of the following signs or symptoms: pain on the right side of your abdomen (stomach area), nausea, tiredness, lack of energy, itching, yellow skin or yellow color in the whites of your eyes, dark urine, or “flu-like” symptoms.

Some of the most common side effects are nose and throat irritation, sinusitis, upper respiratory infection, throat pain, headache, muscle aches, nausea, and diarrhea.

Allergic reactions can happen while taking ZYFLO CR. Tell your health care provider right away if you get any of the following signs or symptoms: rash or hives.

Tell your health care provider if you have any new or unusual symptoms that bother you or do not go away while taking ZYFLO CR.

These are not all of the possible side effects of ZYFLO CR. For more information, ask your health care provider or pharmacist.
